**Ephesians 6:10**Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of His might. <u>11</u>Put on the full armor of God, so that you will be able to stand firm against the schemes of the devil. <u>12</u>For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual *forces* of wickedness in the heavenly *places*. <u>13</u>Therefore, take up the full armor of God, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm. <u>14</u>Stand firm therefore, HAVING GIRDED YOUR LOINS WITH TRUTH, and HAVING PUT ON THE BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS, <u>15</u>and having shod YOUR FEET WITH THE PREPARATION OF THE GOSPEL OF PEACE; <u>16</u>in addition to all, taking up the shield of faith with which you will be able to extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil *one*. <u>17</u>And take THE HELMET OF SALVATION, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
